



Fire Warden & Fire Marshal Training Courses

Designed for:

The person responsible for the day to day running of premises is legally obliged to nominate (name) competent persons to take charge in a fire emergency. These competent persons are commonly referred to as Fire Wardens or Fire Marshals. This course is designed for members of staff nominated as Fire Wardens or Marshals.

Course objectives:

The aim of the course is for Fire Wardens to have greater understanding of the fire risks in the workplace and be able to carry out company procedures. They will learn about fire, the way in which it spreads and the way to fight fire. An understanding of fire safety risks and how to prevent them will be gained. Candidates will use Live Fire Training to learn how to use fire extinguishers correctly and safely.

Course Content:

- Fire safety legislation.
- Basics of combustion.
- Classes of fire.
- Fire extinguishers.
- Fire blankets.
- Fire extinguishers – practical session.
- Actions in the event of a fire.
- The role of the fire warden.
- Fire safety auditing.
- Dealing with arson.
- General fire precautions.
- Course questionnaire, evaluation and close.

Presentation is by Power point and video with Live Fire practical session involving the use of Water and CO2 fire extinguishers (Foam is available on request) and a Fire Blanket.

On completion of the course a Fire Marshal/Fire Warden certificate will be awarded to successful staff. The participating Company are presented with a Corporate Certificate.

Duration depends on the number of delegates and level of interaction with instructor. Suggest 3 hours is allowed.
